1. Data Protection at a Glance

General Notes

Data Collection on Our Website

Who is responsible for collecting data on this website?

How do we collect your data?

What do we use your data for?

What rights do you have regarding your data?

Data Protection

3. Your Rights Regarding Your Data

Withdrawal of Your Consent for Data Processing

Right to File a Complaint with a Supervisory Authority

Right to Data Portability

You have the right to receive the personal data processed by us based on your consent or for contract fulfillment in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format. If you request direct transfer of the data to another entity, this will only be done where technically feasible.

SSL/TLS Encryption

This website uses SSL/TLS encryption for security purposes and to protect the transmission of confidential content. You can recognize an encrypted connection by the fact that the URL changes from "http://" to "https://", and a padlock icon appears in your browser bar.

Information, Blocking, Deletion

4. Data Collection on Our Website

Cookies

Some of our web pages use cookies. Cookies do not harm your computer and do not contain viruses. They help make our website more user-friendly, efficient, and secure. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device and saved by your browser.

Most of the cookies we use are "session cookies", which are automatically deleted after your visit. Other cookies remain on your device until you delete them. These cookies enable us to recognize your browser when you return.

You can configure your browser to notify you when cookies are set and allow cookies only in specific cases, disable cookies for certain scenarios, or delete them when closing your browser. Disabling cookies may limit the functionality of this website.

Cookies necessary for electronic communication or certain functions (e.g., shopping cart functionality) are stored based on Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR. The website operator has a legitimate interest in storing cookies to ensure an optimized and technically flawless service.

Server Log Files

The provider of this website automatically collects and stores information in server log files, which your browser automatically transmits to us. These include:

- Browser type and version
- Operating system used
- Referrer URL
- Host name of the accessing computer

- Time of the server request
- IP address

This data is not merged with other data sources. The legal basis for processing is Art. 6 (1) lit. b GDPR, which allows data processing for the fulfillment of a contract or pre-contractual measures.

Contact Form

If you use our contact form, the data you enter, including the contact details provided, will be stored for processing your request and for follow-up inquiries.

The data entered in the contact form is processed exclusively based on your consent (Art. 6 (1) lit. a GDPR). You can withdraw this consent at any time by emailing us.

5. Plugins and Third-Party Services

Integration of Vimeo Plugins
